Ready-made garments (jacket/hooded jacket, T-shirt [maternity, long sleeve], ladies big shirt, skirt, sweatpants, sweatshirt, polo shirt, tank top, dress, cardigan, bodysuit/overall/romper, pyjama set, night gown, bib, sleeping suit, sleeping bag, ladies top and bottom set, leggings, pants/trousers, swim shorts/shorts) produced from knitted fabrics made of 100 % CO, CO/CMD, 100 % CV, 100 % PES, PES/CV and their blends with EL, CO blends with PES and or with EL, CO/LI, PES/LI, white, reactive/disperse dyed as well as CO/CV, CO/PES/CV and their blends with EL in grey mélange, 100 % CO, CO/CMD, CO/PES, CO/CV in grey mélange and their blends with EL, white and yarn-dyed, with allover/motif pigment (incl. neon), rubber (incl. metallic silver and gold, gel), glitter, glow in the dark print, discharge pigment print on 100 % CO, CO/EL, burnout print on PES/CO, allover reactive print on 100 % CO, CO/EL, 100 % CV, CV/EL, CO/CMD, CO/CMD/EL, all softener finished, flock (PES, white), foil transfer print on CO, CO/EL, CO/PES, CO/CV, CO/CV/EL, CO/PES/CV, fabrics partly brushed, incl. EL(LYCRA®) and CV(LENZING™ Viscose), incl. accessories (sewing thread, PES button, tape, elastic, drawstring, metal tip, eyelet, metal snap button, ring and buckle, zipper, interlining, woven and printed label, lace, reflective transfer print/label, hook and loop fastener, mobilon tape, mesh); produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 6, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 6 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
